#### Stoma clinics are held:

- weekly at Colchester General Hospital
- weekly at Clacton and District Hospital
- monthly at Harwich and District Hospital

Please bring a complete change of equipment if you would like the nurse to examine your stoma.

If you have not seen the stoma nurse for some time you may need your GP to refer you. Please speak to the Stoma Care Department or ask your GP to send a referral letter.

If you are unable to attend your appointment, please contact us on 01206 742009 so we can allocate the slot to someone else.

- discuss the supply and delivery of equipment, including prescription requests
- learn about national and local support groups
- talk about travel and holidays
- discuss any issues of concern to you either practical, psychological or of an intimate nature.
